Police and Fire Departments (and other local first responders)

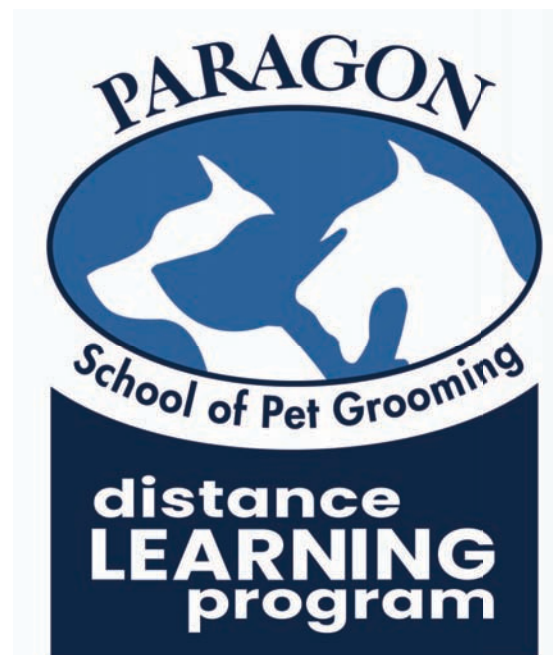
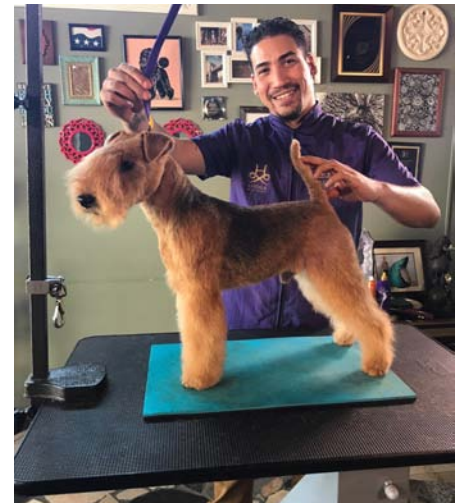
- Dogs are used for a variety of jobs in these environments. They work hard and need baths and grooming to keep them looking their best after work.
